### **Saturday, 13 March 2010 – Cape Town - Hermanus**

After a leisurely breakfast you will be met in the hotel lobby by your registered tour guide. ### **Sunday, 14 March 2010 – Hermanus – Knysna**

Today you depart to Knysna, the popular Garden Route destination in South Africa.

Known as the home of the world's biggest waves, the only snow slopes in Africa, the highest bungee jump in the southern hemisphere and the birthplace of Nelson Mandela, the Garden Route and neighbouring Sunshine Coast are areas of outstanding natural beauty. It is also known for the many world-renowned golf courses, which extend practically the entire length of the coast.

### **Monday, 15 March 2010 – Knysna**

Knysna is a natural paradise of lush, indigenous forests, tranquil lakes and golden beaches. She nestles on the banks of a breathtakingly pretty lagoon, now a protected marine reserve that is home to the extraordinary sea horse and over 200 species of fish. Beaches, lakes, mountains and rivers provide endless opportunity for leisure and outdoor adventure. Within the town, craft shops, flea-markets and cosy cafés beckon with small-town charm and hospitality. The area around Knysna is a veritable Garden of Eden. This is home of the only forest elephant in South Africa, the rare Pansy Shell, the brilliantly coloured, and elusive, Knysna Loerie, a plethora of waterfowl and forest birds, dolphins and visiting whales.



### **Tuesday, 16 March 2010 – Day Excursion to Plettenberg Bay**

Plettenberg Bay, or Plett, as it is more familiarly known, is the most fashionable spot on the Garden Route and has been called the Riviera of Africa. It's no exaggeration. With fabulous beaches stretching for miles, whole neighbourhoods of expensive summer homes hogging the best views, a couple of championship golf courses, and about a dozen world class polo fields, it's definitely the playground of the rich.

But there's more to Plett than glitz and glamour. It's one of the best boat based whale and dolphin watching destinations in the world, the diving is good, the surfing is great, and the fabulous Harkerville mountain biking trails are about halfway between Plett and Knysna. There are some awesome hikes close to the town and loads of great day walks. You can do a tandem skydive, fly in a glider or just do a scenic whale and dolphin watching flight.



### **Wednesday, 17 March 2010 – Knysna – Port Elizabeth – Kwandwe Private Game Reserve**

Depart Knysna. On route to your final destination, Kwandwe Game Reserve, visit Tsitsikamma National Park. Tsitsikamma is a Khoisan word meaning, "place of much water". The Park incorporates 80 km of rocky coastline with spectacular sea and landscapes, a remote mountainous region with secluded valleys covered in mountain Fynbos and temperate high forests with deep river gorges leading down to the sea. Take a short walk to the hanging bridge crossing the Storms River mouth. Then continue along the N2 to Grahamstown and Kwandwe Game Reserve. Your guide will make sure you arrive around lunchtime – in order to have time to relax and freshen up before the first afternoon game drive. He will then say goodbye and leave you in the capable hands of the lodge staff & rangers.
