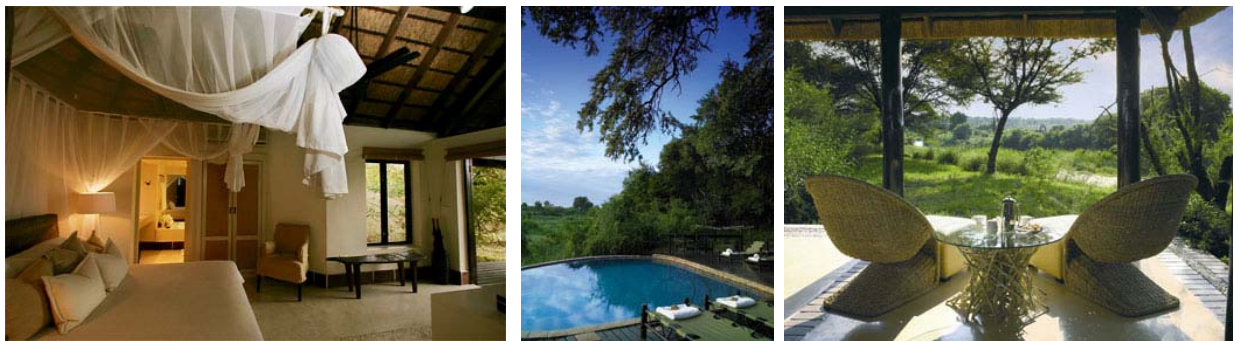




ICA 2010 – Premier Wildlife Safari

Saturday, 13 March 2010 - Cape Town – Johannesburg – Sabi Sand Game Reserve

This morning a transfer will take you to Cape Town Airport where you will check- in for your domestic flight to Johannesburg. On arrival in Johannesburg a representative of Federal Air will take you through to the Fedair departure lounge where you can relax until your scheduled air transfer into the Sabi Sands Game Reserve departs. The duration of this scheduled charter flight depends on the amount of stopovers as this is not a private charter and other guests will have to be dropped at other lodges in the Sabi Sands (maximum “ hops” from lodge to lodge: 3)



Lion Sands River Lodge

River Lodge is the soul of Lion Sands and has been built on the banks of the Sabie River, positioned on a site with trees dating back 800 years. Facing due east, the lodge catches the sun as it rises over the Kruger National Park. Hosted by a family of staff that make it feel like home away from home, the lodge is about spirit, warmth and nature. Here you are invited to relax and experience African hospitality at its finest.

The public areas at River Lodge offers guests the following: a private lounge and bar with fireplace, an outdoor safari lounge, 2 swimming pools (heated in winter), wooden viewing decks, a secluded bird hide, a magnificent River Island Deck built on the river, a conference room, Lalamuka Health Spa & gymnasium, curio shop & both an indoor and open-air (Boma) dining area.

The rooms at River Lodge offer respite and protection from the Lowveld heat. The interior is a tranquil cream and beige haven, cool in the summer, cosy in the winter. The bathroom, with its tranquil look and

pebble-inlaid floors complements the bushveld well. There are 18 luxurious thatched bedrooms with en-suite bathroom, outdoor & inside shower & wooden viewing deck. The bedroom area is air-conditioned with an overhead fan. All rooms have mini-bar & telephone access. The rooms are linked to all areas by raised wooden walkways.

The philosophy of the safari experience at Lion Sands is to deliver a consistently professional, informative & holistic safari experience, ensuring that all spheres of the eco-system, from the small insects to the mighty African elephant, are covered in as much detail as the Guest may require. The Senior Ecologist, Field Ranger & Tracker teams have been carefully selected to make certain that your Safari Experience will not only meet but exceed your highest expectations.

Sunday, 14 March 2010 - Safari at Lion Sands

Enjoy the day game viewing, the lodge offers an early morning (05h30) and late afternoon (16h00) game drive, which may extend into a night drive with spotlights. In between gourmet meals and game drives relax on the River Island Deck or partake in an interpretive bush walk (11h00) or enjoy a massage at the Spa. You will find the days pass way too quickly with everything that Lion Sands offers.

Monday, 15 March 2010 – Safari at Lion Sands

Tuesday, 16 March 2010 – Departure

After a last game drive and scrumptious breakfast your Federal Air flight will take you back to Johannesburg (OR Tambo International) in time for your flight back to Cape Town.
